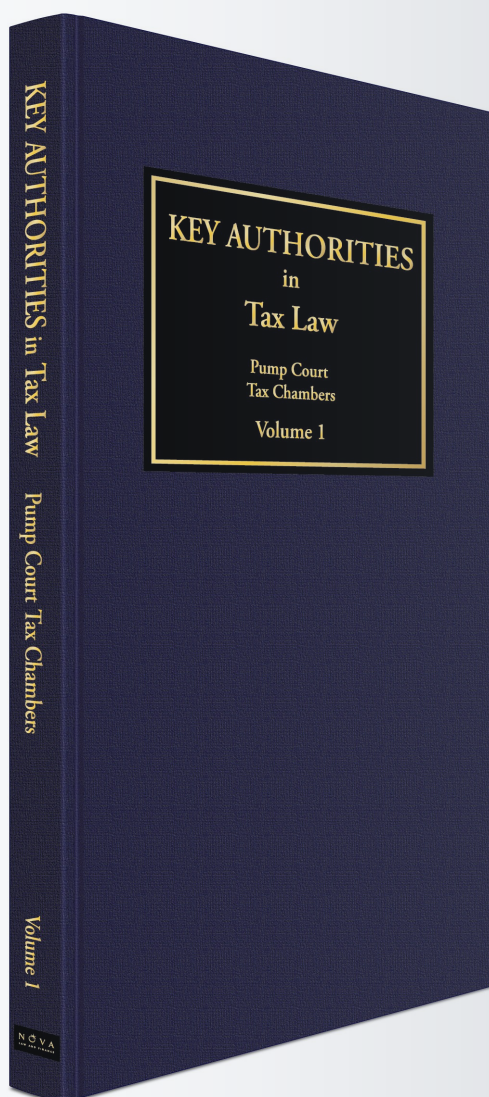

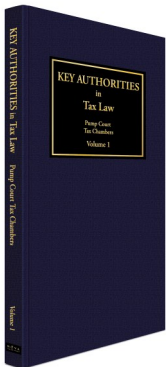

### ***Editorials***

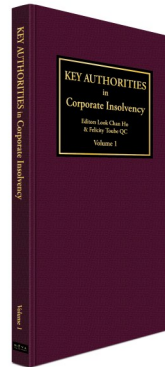
